Now that I have a better understanding of the 2 times Father will arise during the day of the Lord, I can now divide all of these verses into Father's 1<sup>st</sup> coming and His 2<sup>nd</sup> coming. He first comes to start the day of the Lord and then comes again at the 7<sup>th</sup> Bowl to raise up His Son Jesus and to present us with Him.

I will use the background color of yellow to designate the 6<sup>th</sup> Seal start to the day of the Lord and the background color turquoise to represent the 7<sup>th</sup> Bowl raising up of Jesus and all that belong to Him. I will also use the color green to designate Israel finally acknowledging their offense and calling upon the name of Jesus around the time of the 7<sup>th</sup> Trumpet.

#### $\mathbf{6}^{\text{th}}$ Seal rising up of Father to begin His awesome work

### Hosea 5:14-15 NKJV

# $7^{\rm th}\,\text{Bowl}\,$ The Lord of hosts raises up Jesus and gathers to Him all that belong to Him

**Isaiah 31:4-5 God Will Deliver Jerusalem** <sup>4</sup> For thus the LORD has spoken to me: "As a lion roars, and a young lion over his prey (When a multitude of shepherds is summoned against him, *He* will not be afraid of their voice nor be disturbed by their noise), **so the LORD of hosts will come down** to fight for Mount Zion and for its hill. <sup>5</sup> Like birds flying about, so will the LORD of hosts defend Jerusalem. Defending, He will also deliver *it*; passing over, He will preserve *it*."

**2 Corinthians 4:14** knowing that He who raised up the Lord Jesus will also **raise us up with Jesus, and** will present us with you.

**Isaiah 26:19** Your dead shall live; *Together with* my dead body they **shall ARISE**. Awake and sing, you who dwell in dust; for your dew *is like* the dew of herbs, and the earth shall cast out the dead.

<u>Malachi 4:2</u> But to you who fear My name **The Sun of Righteousness shall ARISE** with healing in His wings; and you shall go out and grow fat like stall-fed calves.

**Zechariah 9:14** Then the **LORD will be seen** over them, and His arrow **will GO FORTH** like lightning. **The Lord GoD will blow the trumpet**, and **GO** with whirlwinds from the south.

**Hosea 6:3** Let us know, let us pursue the knowledge of the LORD. His GOING FORTH is established as the morning; **He WILL COME** to us like the rain, like the latter *and* former rain to the earth.

Zechariah 14:3 Then the Lord will GO FORTH and fight against those nations, As He fights in the day of battle.

**Zephaniah 3:8** "Therefore wait for Me," says the **LORD**, "Until the day **I RISE up** for plunder; My determination *is* to gather the nations To My assembly of kingdoms, to pour on them My indignation, all My fierce anger; all the earth shall be devoured with the fire of My jealousy.

**Luke 13:25** When once **the Master of the house has RISEN up** and shut the door, and you begin to stand outside and knock at the door, saying, 'Lord, Lord, open for us,' and He will answer and say to you, 'I do not know you, where you are from,'

<u>Isaiah 14:22</u> "For I will RISE up against them," says the LORD of hosts, "and cut off from Babylon the name and remnant, and offspring and posterity," says the LORD.

**Isaiah 33:3** At the noise of the tumult the people shall flee; when **You lift Yourself up**, the nations shall be scattered;

Isaiah 33:10 "Now I will RISE," says the LORD; "Now I will be exalted, now I will Lift Myself up.

**Isaiah 60:1-2 ARISE**, shine; for your light has come! and the **glory of the LORD is RISEN** upon you. For behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, and deep darkness the people; But the **LORD will ARISE** over you, and His glory will be seen upon you.

<u>Psalm 12:5</u> "For the oppression of the poor, for the sighing of the needy, now I will ARISE," says the LORD; "I will set *him* in the safety for which he yearns."

## When is the Rapture of those who are alive and remain?

This is the Day that Jesus is presented at the 7<sup>th</sup> Bowl with all who belong to Him. He will Judge the Living and the Deal on the last day. All Chosen Elect Branches on the Tree of Life whether asleep or alive must "WAIT patiently" on their Lord until the Day He rises up to take Plunder on those who plundered His people. This is the Day that Jesus: Musters the Armies of Heaven, Marries His Bride, Judges the nations, Makes War, and renders Vengeance on those Marked Perjurers who spilled the innocent blood.

Those who are alive and remain will **MEET** their Lord when He SCREAMS "**IT IS DONE**" (Rev 16:17, Ps 52:9, Isa 41:4) at the pouring of the 7<sup>th</sup> BOWL and **STAND BEFORE the Lord**. (Luke 21:36, Jer 15:19, Mal 3:2)
