

This document lists most of the 7th Bowl, 6th Seal and 7th Trumpet “BEHOLD verses” in the Holy Bible. This study of the {**NKJV** “BEHOLDS”} will open eyes to many of the 70th Week of Daniel passages in the Bible.

7th Bowl Beholds

All of these verses are talking about the same event mentioned in Rev 16:15

“BEHOLD I am coming as a THIEF blessed is he who watches, and keeps his garments, lest he walk naked and **they see his shame**”

These verses in the Holy Bible are talking about **1 Event**. At the end of this first section I will show you what verse / event all of these are explaining. At the end of this section I will also list these verses in the order they were shown to you. These are the climax to the Wrath of God called the **Wrath of the Lamb**.

“Behold, the Lord, the LORD of hosts, will lop off the bough with terror; those of high stature *will be* hewn down, and the haughty will be humbled.”

“Behold, God *is* my salvation, I will trust and not be afraid; For YAH, the LORD, *is* my strength and song; He also has become my salvation.”

“Then **behold**, at eventide, trouble! *And* before the morning, he *is* no more. This *is* the portion of those who plunder us, and the lot of those who rob us.”

“The burden against Egypt. **Behold**, the LORD rides on a swift cloud, and will come into Egypt; the idols of Egypt will totter at His presence, and the heart of Egypt will melt in its midst.”

“Behold, the LORD makes the earth empty and makes it waste, distorts its surface and scatters abroad its inhabitants.”

“And it will be said in that day: **“Behold**, this *is* our God; we have waited for Him, and He will save us. This *is* the LORD; we have waited for Him; we will be glad and rejoice in His salvation.””

“Let grace be shown to the wicked, yet he will not learn righteousness; in the land of uprightness he will deal unjustly, and will not **behold** the majesty of the LORD.”

“For **behold**, the LORD comes out of His place to punish the inhabitants of the earth for their iniquity; the earth will also disclose her blood, and will no more cover her slain.”

“Behold, the Lord has a mighty and strong one, like a tempest of hail and a destroying storm, like a flood of mighty waters overflowing, who will bring *them* down to the earth with *His* hand.”

“Behold, the name of the LORD comes from afar, burning *with* His anger, and *His* burden *is* heavy; His lips are full of indignation, and His tongue like a devouring fire.”

“Say to those *who are* fearful-hearted, “be strong, do not fear! **Behold**, your God will come *with* vengeance, *with* the recompense of God; He will come and save you.””

“O Zion, you who bring good tidings, get up into the high mountain; O Jerusalem, you who bring good tidings, lift up your voice with strength, lift *it* up, be not afraid; Say to the cities of Judah, “**Behold** your God!””

“**Behold**, the Lord GOD shall come with a strong *hand*, and His arm shall rule for Him; **Behold**, His reward *is* with Him, and His work before Him.”

“**Behold**, the nations *are* as a drop in a bucket, and are counted as the small dust on the scales; look, He lifts up the isles as a very little thing.”

“**Behold**, all those who were incensed against you shall be ashamed and disgraced; they shall be as nothing, and those who strive with you shall perish.”

“**Behold**, I will make *you* into a new threshing sledge with sharp teeth; *you* shall thresh the mountains and beat *them* small, and make the hills like chaff.”

“**Behold!** My Servant whom I uphold, My Elect One *in whom* My soul delights! I have put My Spirit upon Him; He will bring forth justice to the Gentiles.”

“**Behold**, I will do a new thing, now it shall spring forth; shall you not know it? I will even make a road in the wilderness *and* rivers in the desert.”

“**Behold**, they shall be as stubble, the *fire* shall burn them; they shall not deliver themselves from the power of the flame; *It shall* not be a coal to be warmed by, *Nor* a fire to sit before!”

“**Behold**, I have refined you, but not as silver; I have tested you in the furnace of affliction.”

“Thus says the Lord GOD: “**Behold**, I will lift My hand in an oath to the nations, and set up My standard for the peoples; they shall

bring your sons in *their* arms, and your daughters shall be carried on *their* shoulders;”

“Therefore My people shall know My name; Therefore *they shall know* in that day That *I am* He who speaks: ‘**Behold, it is I.**’”

“For **behold**, the darkness shall cover the earth, and deep darkness the people; but the LORD will arise over you, and His glory will be seen upon you.”

“Indeed the LORD has proclaimed to the end of the world: “Say to the daughter of Zion, ‘surely your salvation is coming; **Behold**, His reward *is* with Him, and His work before Him.’”

“**Behold, it is** written before Me: I will not keep silence, but will repay— Even repay into their bosom—“

“Therefore thus says the Lord GOD: “**Behold, My servants** shall eat, but you shall be hungry; **Behold, My servants** shall drink, but you shall be thirsty; **Behold, My servants** shall rejoice, but you shall be ashamed;”

“**Behold, My servants** shall sing for joy of heart, but you shall cry for sorrow of heart, and wail for grief of spirit.”

“But be glad and rejoice forever in what I create; for **behold**, I create Jerusalem as a rejoicing, and her people a joy.”

“For thus says the LORD: “**Behold**, I will extend peace to her like a river, and the glory of the Gentiles like a flowing stream. Then you shall feed; on *her* sides shall you be carried, and be dandled on *her* knees.”

“For **behold**, the LORD will come with **fire** and with **His chariots, like a whirlwind**, to render His anger with fury, and His rebuke with flames of fire.”

“**Behold, the days are coming,**” says the LORD, “That I will raise to David a **Branch of righteousness**; A **King** shall reign and prosper, and execute judgment and righteousness in the earth.”

“Behold, a whirlwind of the LORD has gone forth in fury— A violent whirlwind! It will fall violently on the head of the wicked.”

“Thus says the LORD of hosts: **“Behold**, disaster shall go forth from nation to nation, and a **great whirlwind shall be raised up** from the farthest parts of the earth.”

“For **behold**, the days are coming,’ says the LORD, ‘that I will bring back from captivity My people Israel and Judah,’ says the LORD. ‘And I will cause them to return to the land that I gave to their fathers, and they shall possess it.’”

“Therefore do not fear, O My servant Jacob,’ says the LORD, ‘nor be dismayed, O Israel; For **behold**, I will save you from afar, and your seed from the land of their captivity. Jacob shall return, have rest and be quiet, and no one shall make *him* afraid.”

“Thus says the LORD: ‘**Behold**, I will bring back the captivity of Jacob’s tents, and have mercy on his dwelling places; The city shall be built upon its own mound, and the palace shall remain according to its own plan.”

“Behold, the whirlwind of the LORD goes forth with fury, a continuing whirlwind; It will fall violently on the head of the wicked.”

“Behold, I will bring them from the north country, and gather them from the ends of the earth, *among* them the blind and the lame, the woman with child and the one who labors with child, together; A great throng shall return there.”

“Behold, the days are coming, says the LORD, that the city shall be built for the LORD from the Tower of Hananel to the Corner Gate.”

“Behold, I *am* the LORD, the God of all flesh. Is there anything too hard for Me?”

“Behold, I will gather them out of all countries where I have driven them in My anger, in My fury, and in great wrath; I will

bring them back to this place, and I will cause them to dwell safely.”

“**Behold**, I will bring it health and healing; I will heal them and reveal to them the abundance of peace and truth.”

‘**Behold**, the days are coming,’ says the LORD, ‘that I will perform that good thing which I have promised to the house of Israel and to the house of Judah:’

“The LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, says: “**Behold**, I will bring punishment on Amon of No, and Pharaoh and Egypt, with their gods and their kings—Pharaoh and those who trust in him.”

“But do not fear, O My servant Jacob, and do not be dismayed, O Israel! For **behold**, I will save you from afar, and your offspring from the land of their captivity; Jacob shall return, have rest and be at ease; No one shall make *him* afraid.”

“Therefore **behold**, the days are coming,” says the LORD, “That I will cause to be heard an alarm of war in Rabbah of the Ammonites; It shall be a desolate mound, and her villages shall be burned with fire. Then Israel shall take possession of his inheritance,” says the LORD.”

“**Behold**, I will bring fear upon you,” Says the Lord GOD of hosts, “From all those who are around you; you shall be driven out, everyone headlong, and no one will gather those who wander off.”

“For thus says the LORD: “**Behold**, those whose judgment *was* not to drink of the cup have assuredly drunk. And *are* you the one who will altogether go unpunished? You shall not go unpunished, but you shall surely drink *of it*.”

“**Behold**, he shall come up like a lion from the floodplain of the Jordan against the dwelling place of the strong; But I will suddenly make him run away from her. And who *is* a chosen *man that* I may appoint over her? For who *is* like Me? Who will arraign Me? And who *is* that shepherd who will withstand Me?”

“Behold, He shall come up and fly like the eagle, and spread His wings over Bozrah; The heart of the mighty men of Edom in that day shall be like the heart of a woman in birth pangs.”

“Thus says the LORD of hosts: **‘Behold**, I will break the bow of Elam, the foremost of their might.”

“For **behold**, I will raise and cause to come up against Babylon an assembly of great nations from the north country, and they shall array themselves against her; from there she shall be captured. Their arrows *shall be* like *those* of an expert warrior; none shall return in vain.”

“Therefore thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel:
“Behold, I will punish the king of Babylon and his land, as I have punished the king of Assyria.”

“Behold, I *am* against you, O most haughty one!” says the Lord GOD of hosts; “For your day has come, the time *that* I will punish you.”

“Behold, a people shall come from the north, and a great nation and many kings shall be raised up from the ends of the earth.”

“Behold, he shall come up like a lion from the floodplain of the Jordan against the dwelling place of the strong; but I will make them suddenly run away from her. And who *is* a chosen *man that* I may appoint over her? For who *is* like Me? Who will arraign Me? And who *is* that shepherd who will withstand Me?”

“Thus says the LORD: **“Behold**, I will **raise up** against Babylon, against those who dwell in Leb Kamai, a destroying wind.”

“Behold, I *am* against you, O destroying mountain, who destroys all the earth,” says the LORD. “And I will stretch out My hand against you, roll you down from the rocks, and make you a burnt mountain.”

“Therefore thus says the LORD: **“Behold**, I will plead your case and take vengeance for you. I will dry up her sea and make her springs dry.”

“Therefore **behold**, the days are coming that I will bring judgment on the carved images of Babylon; her whole land shall be ashamed, and all her slain shall fall in her midst.”

“Therefore **behold**, the days are coming,” says the LORD, “That I will bring judgment on her carved images, and throughout all her land the wounded shall groan.”

“Then I looked, and **behold**, a whirlwind was coming out of the north, a great cloud with raging fire engulfing itself; and brightness was all around it and radiating out of its midst like the color of amber, out of the midst of the fire.”

“Now as I looked at the living creatures, **behold**, a wheel was on the earth beside each living creature with its four faces.”

“Therefore, **behold**, I will clear the territory of Moab of cities, of the cities on its frontier, the glory of the country, Beth Jeshimoth, Baal Meon, and Kirjathaim.”

“‘And as for you, O My flock, thus says the Lord GOD: “**Behold**, I shall judge between sheep and sheep, between rams and goats.”

“‘Therefore thus says the Lord GOD to them: “**Behold**, I Myself will judge between the fat and the lean sheep.”

“and say to it, ‘Thus says the Lord GOD: “**Behold**, O Mount Seir, I *am* against you; I will stretch out My hand against you, and make you most desolate;”

“Therefore prophesy concerning the land of Israel, and say to the mountains, the hills, the rivers, and the valleys, ‘thus says the Lord GOD: “**Behold**, I have spoken in My jealousy and My fury, because you have borne the shame of the nations.”

“**Therefore prophesy and say to them, ‘Thus says the Lord GOD: “Behold, O My people, I will open your graves and cause you to come up from your graves, and bring you into the land of Israel.”**

"The LORD will answer and say to His people, "**Behold**, I will send you grain and new wine and oil, and you will be satisfied by them; I will no longer make you a reproach among the nations."

"For **behold**, in those days and at that time, when I bring back the captives of Judah and Jerusalem,"

"Behold, I will raise them out of the place to which you have sold them, and will return your retaliation upon your own head."

"For **behold**, the LORD is coming out of His place; He will come down and tread on the high places of the earth."

"Behold, on the mountains the feet of him who brings good tidings, who proclaims peace! O Judah, keep your appointed feasts, perform your vows. For the wicked one shall no more pass through you; he is utterly cut off."

"Behold, I *am* against you," says the LORD of hosts, "I will burn your chariots in smoke, and the sword shall devour your young lions; I will cut off your prey from the earth, and the voice of your messengers shall be heard no more."

"Behold, I *am* against you," says the LORD of hosts; "I will lift your skirts over your face, I will show the nations your nakedness, and the kingdoms your shame."

"Behold, at that time I will deal with all who afflict you; I will save the lame, and gather those who were driven out; I will appoint them for praise and fame in every land where they were put to shame."

"Sing and rejoice, O daughter of Zion! For **behold**, I am coming and **I will dwell in your midst,**" says the LORD"

'Hear, O Joshua, the high priest, you and your companions who sit before you, for they are a wondrous sign; for **behold**, I am bringing forth **My Servant the BRANCH.**"

"For **behold**, the stone that I have laid before Joshua: upon the stone *are* seven eyes. **Behold**, I will engrave its inscription,' Says

the LORD of hosts, ‘and I will remove the iniquity of that land in one day.”

“Then speak to him, saying, ‘thus says the LORD of hosts, saying: “**Behold**, the Man whose name is the BRANCH! From His place He shall branch out, and He shall build the temple of the LORD;”

“Thus says the LORD of hosts: ‘**Behold**, I will save My people from the land of the east and from the land of the west;”

“**Behold**, the Lord will cast her out; He will destroy her power in the sea, and she will be devoured by fire.”

“Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion! Shout, O daughter of Jerusalem! **Behold**, your King is coming to you; He is just and having salvation, lowly and riding on a donkey, a colt, the foal of a donkey.”

“**Behold**, I will make Jerusalem a cup of drunkenness to all the surrounding peoples, when they lay siege against Judah and Jerusalem.”

“**Behold**, the day of the LORD is coming, and your spoil will be divided in your midst.”

“**Behold**, I send My messenger, and he will prepare the way before Me. And the Lord, whom you seek, will suddenly come to His temple, even the Messenger of the covenant, in whom you delight. **Behold**, He is coming,” Says the LORD of hosts.”

“For **behold**, the day is coming, burning like an oven, and all the proud, yes, all who do wickedly will be stubble. And the day which is coming shall burn them up,” says the LORD of hosts, “that will leave them neither root nor branch.”

“Thus you shall say to him, ‘Thus says the LORD: “**Behold**, what I have built I will break down, and what I have planted I will pluck up, that is, this whole land. ⁵And do you seek great things for yourself? Do not seek *them*; for **behold**, I will bring

adversity on all flesh,” says the LORD. “But I will give your life to you as a prize in all places, wherever you go.””

“**Behold**, I tell you a mystery: We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed—“

“Now Enoch, the seventh from Adam, prophesied about these men also, saying, “**Behold**, the Lord comes with ten thousands of His saints,”

“**Behold**, He is coming with clouds, and every eye will see Him, even they who pierced Him. And all the tribes of the earth will mourn because of Him. Even so, Amen.”

“I *am* He who lives, and was dead, and **behold**, I am alive forevermore. Amen. And I have the keys of Hades and of Death.”

“**Behold**, I am coming quickly! Hold fast what you have, that no one may take your crown.”

“Then I looked, and **behold**, a Lamb standing on Mount Zion, and with Him one hundred *and* forty-four thousand, having His Father’s name written on their foreheads.”

“Then I looked, and **behold**, a white cloud, and on the cloud sat *One* like the Son of Man, having on His head a golden crown, and in His hand a sharp sickle.”

“After these things I looked, and **behold**, the temple of the tabernacle of the testimony in heaven was opened.”

“**Behold**, I am coming as a thief. Blessed *is* he who watches, and keeps his garments, lest he walk naked and they see his shame.”

“Now I saw heaven opened, and **behold**, a white horse. And He who sat on him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and makes war.”

“And I heard a loud voice from heaven saying, “**Behold**, the tabernacle of God *is* with men, and He will dwell with them, and they shall be His people. God Himself will be with them *and* be their God.”

“Then He who sat on the throne said, “**Behold**, I make all things new.” And He said to me, “Write, for these words are true and faithful.”

“**Behold**, I am coming quickly! Blessed *is* he who keeps the words of the prophecy of this book.”

All of these “Behold” passages are concerning the Return of Jesus to be set up as Ruler of the Planet by His Father. This will occur at the pouring of the 7th Bowl. ([Rev 16:15](#)) It is truly amazing to see which Old Testament chapters are all about our FUTURE!!! Now that you know they are about our future go back and read them again.

Note: Here is the moment Isaac and Rebekah’s eyes **MEET** for the first time: [Gen 24:63-64](#). Here is the moment in the Evening Time that the Beautiful Virgin

came out to draw WATER from the well (of salvation):
Gen 24:15-16. {Isa 17:14 & Zech 14:7}

Here is Lord God Jesus' attitude toward the few people that will be alive from Israel's enemies following the Battle of the Great Day of God Almighty. He will bring the few dispersed ones from Israel's enemies back to their land IF they only swear by the Holy one of Israel and His Christ. If they refuse their entire seed line will die during the early days of the Millennium.

Jer 12:14-17

¹⁴Thus says the LORD: "Against all My evil neighbors who touch the inheritance which I have caused My people Israel to inherit—**behold**, I will pluck them out of their land and pluck out the house of Judah from among them. ¹⁵Then it shall be, after I have plucked them out, that I will return and have compassion on them and bring them back, everyone to his heritage and everyone to his land. ¹⁶**And it shall be, if they will learn carefully the ways of My people, to swear by My name, 'As the LORD lives,'** as they taught My people to swear by Baal, then they shall be established in the midst of My people. ¹⁷But if they do not obey, I will utterly pluck up and destroy that nation," says the LORD.

6th Seal Beholds

All of these verses are talking about the same event mentioned in 1 Thessalonians 5:2.

“For you yourselves know perfectly that the day of the Lord so comes as a thief in the night.”

Below is a list of “**BEHOLD**” verses in the Bible that refer to the start of the **CURSE** that begins *the day* the **6th Seal is loosed**. The **CURSE** ends at end of the 6th Bowl. These

Beholds also start the “day of the Lord”. It runs from the **7th Seal opening of the scroll** thru the end of the Battle of the Great Day of God Almighty. (note here that the **Great Tribulation** begins during the early days of the 5th Seal when satan will be cast to earth with authority.) His authority runs out at the 7th Trumpet but he will not be put in chains until the many days of the Battle of the Great Day of God Almighty are completed. There are **3 phases to the “day of the Lord”**. **1.)** wrath of the Lord of hosts on His people {first 4 Trumpets} **2.)** day of His fierce anger on His people {3 woes} **3.)** Day of His fierce anger on His enemies. {7th Bowl treading and threshing during the Battle of the Great Day}

Question: **What is the purpose of the CURSE** that is in the scroll? **Another words what is the**

purpose of the day of the Lord that comes as a thief?

Answer: It has 2 purposes. 1.) It is the promised CURSE of Deuteronomy 32. The last generation of Israel must pay for their own transgressions if they will not repent and accept the blood atonement of their true messiah.

Isa 1:24-28 NKJV

²⁴Therefore the Lord says,
The LORD of hosts, the Mighty One of Israel,
“Ah, I will rid Myself of My adversaries,
And take vengeance on My enemies.

²⁵I will turn My hand against you,
**And thoroughly purge away your dross,
And take away all your alloy.**

²⁶I will restore your judges as at the first,
And your counselors as at the beginning.
Afterward you shall be called the city of righteousness, the faithful city.”

²⁷Zion shall be redeemed with justice,
And her penitents with righteousness.

²⁸The destruction of transgressors and of sinners *shall be* together,
And those who forsake the LORD shall be consumed.

Zech 13:7-9 NKJV

⁷“Awake, O sword, against My Shepherd,
Against the Man who is My Companion,”
Says the LORD of hosts.
“Strike the Shepherd,
And the sheep will be scattered;
Then I will turn My hand against the little ones.
⁸And it shall come to pass **in all the land,”**
Says the LORD,
“*That* two-thirds in it shall be cut off *and* die,
But *one*-third shall be left in it:
⁹**I will bring the *one*-third through the fire,**
Will refine them as silver is refined,
And test them as gold is tested.
They will call on My name,
And I will answer them.
I will say, ‘This *is* My people’;
And each one will say, ‘The LORD *is* my God.’ ”

2.) The second purpose of the CURSE is found
in Zechariah 5:3-4 Then he said to me,
“This *is* the **curse** that goes out over the face of the
whole earth: ‘**Every thief shall be expelled,**
according to this side of *the scroll*; and, ‘**Every perjurer**
shall be expelled,’ according to that side of it.” “I will
send out **the curse,**” says the LORD of hosts; “It shall enter
the **house of the thief** and the **house of the one who**
swears falsely by My name. It shall remain in the midst
of his house and consume it, with its timber and stones.”

NOTE that expelled means cast out of the kingdom or cut off from the kingdom. (bundled then burned)

It is also found in **Ezekiel 38:18-23** “And it will come to pass at the same time, when Gog comes against the land of Israel,” says the Lord GOD, “*that* My fury will show in **My face**.¹⁹ For in My jealousy *and* in the fire of My wrath I have spoken: ‘Surely in that day there shall be a **great earthquake** in the {*land of Israel*},²⁰ so that the fish of the sea, the birds of the heavens, the beasts of the field, all creeping things that creep on the earth, and all men who *are* on the face of the earth shall shake at **My presence**. The mountains shall be thrown down, the steep places shall fall, and every wall shall fall to the ground.’²¹ I will call for a sword against Gog throughout all My mountains,” says the Lord GOD. “Every man’s sword will be against his brother.²² And I will bring him **to judgment** with pestilence and bloodshed; I will rain down on him, on his troops, and on the many peoples who *are* with him, **flooding rain, great hailstones, fire, and brimstone**.²³ **Thus I will magnify Myself and sanctify Myself, and I will be known in the eyes of many nations. Then they shall know that I *am* the LORD.**”

Judgment on Israel Is Near

7 Moreover the word of the LORD came to me, saying, ²“And you, son of man, thus says the Lord GOD to the land of Israel:

Do not seek *them*; for **behold**, I will bring adversity on all flesh," says the LORD. "But I will give your life to you as a prize in all places, wherever you go."'"

Behold, the day of the LORD comes, Cruel, with both wrath and fierce anger, to lay the land desolate; and He will destroy its sinners from it.

Isa 5:24-30 Therefore, as the fire devours the stubble, and the flame consumes the chaff, so their root will be as rottenness, and their blossom will ascend like dust; because they have rejected the law of the LORD of hosts, and despised the word of the Holy One of Israel. ²⁵ Therefore the anger of the LORD is aroused against His people; He has stretched out His hand against them and stricken them, and the hills trembled. Their carcasses *were* as refuse in the midst of the streets. But His hand *is* stretched out still.

²⁶He will lift up a banner to the nations from afar, and will whistle to them from the end of the earth;
Surely they shall come with **speed, swiftly**. ²⁷No one will be weary or stumble among them,
no one will slumber or sleep; Nor will the belt on their loins be loosed, nor the strap of their sandals be broken; ²⁸Whose arrows *are* sharp, and all their bows bent; their horses' hooves will seem like flint,
and their wheels like a whirlwind. ²⁹Their roaring *will be* like a lion, they will roar like young lions;
Yes, they will roar and lay hold of the prey; they will carry *it* away safely, And no one will deliver. ³⁰In that day they will roar against them like the roaring of the sea. And if *one* looks to the land, **Behold, darkness and sorrow; and the light is darkened by the clouds.**

Isa 8:5-10 ⁵The LORD also spoke to me again, saying: ⁶"Inasmuch as these people refused the waters of Shiloah that flow softly, and rejoice in Rezin and in Remaliah's son; ⁷Now therefore, **behold**, the Lord brings up over them the waters of the River, strong and mighty— The **king of Assyria** and all his glory; he will go up over all his channels and go over all his banks. ⁸He will **pass through Judah**, He will overflow and **pass over**, He will reach up to the neck; and the stretching out of his wings will fill the breadth of Your land, O Immanuel. ⁹"Be shattered, O you peoples, and be broken in pieces! Give ear, all you from far countries. Gird yourselves, but **be broken in pieces**; gird yourselves, but **be broken in pieces**.
¹⁰Take counsel together, but **it will come to nothing**; *speak the word*, but **it will not stand**, For God *is* with us."

Jer 1:11-16 ¹¹Moreover the word of the LORD came to me, saying, "Jeremiah, what do you see?" And I said, "I see a **branch of an almond tree**." ¹²Then the LORD said to me, "You have seen well, for I am ready to perform My word." ¹³And the word of the LORD came to me the second time, saying, "What do you see?" And I said, "I see a boiling pot, and it is facing away from the north." ¹⁴Then the LORD said to me: "Out of the north calamity shall break forth on all the inhabitants of the land.
¹⁵For **behold**, I am calling all the families of the kingdoms of the north," says

the LORD; “they shall come and each one set his throne at the entrance of the gates of Jerusalem, against all its walls all around, and against all the cities of Judah. ¹⁶ I will utter **My judgments** against them concerning all their wickedness, because they have forsaken Me, burned incense to other gods, and worshiped the works of their own hands.

Jer 4:10-14 ¹⁰ Then I said, “Ah, Lord GOD! Surely You have greatly deceived this people and Jerusalem, Saying, ‘You shall have peace,’ Whereas the sword reaches to the heart.” ¹¹ **At that time** it will be said to this people and to Jerusalem, “a dry wind of the desolate heights *blows* in the wilderness toward the daughter of My people— Not to fan or to cleanse— ¹² A wind too strong for these will come **for Me**; Now I will also speak **judgment** against them.” ¹³ **Behold**, he shall come up like clouds, and his chariots like a whirlwind. His horses are swifter than eagles. Woe to us, for we are plundered!” ¹⁴ O Jerusalem, wash your heart from wickedness, that you may be saved. **How long** shall your evil thoughts lodge within you?

Jer 5:14-17 ¹⁴ Therefore thus says the LORD God of hosts. “Because you speak this word, **Behold**, I will make My words in your mouth fire, and this people wood, and it shall devour them. ¹⁵ **Behold**, I will bring a nation against you from afar, O house of Israel,” says the LORD. “It *is* a mighty nation, it *is* an ancient nation, a nation whose language you do not know, nor can you understand what they say. ¹⁶ Their quiver *is* like an open tomb; they *are* all mighty men. ¹⁷ And they shall eat up your harvest and your bread, *which* your sons and daughters should eat. They shall eat up your flocks and your herds; they shall eat up your vines and your fig trees; they shall destroy your fortified cities, in which you trust, with the sword.

Jer 6:19-26 ¹⁹ Hear, O earth! **Behold**, I will certainly bring calamity on this people— The fruit of their thoughts, because they have not heeded My words Nor My law, but rejected it. ²⁰ For what purpose to Me comes frankincense from Sheba, and sweet cane from a far country? Your burnt offerings *are* not acceptable, nor your sacrifices sweet to Me.” ²¹ Therefore thus says the LORD: “**Behold**, I will lay stumbling blocks before this people, and the fathers and the sons together shall fall on them. The neighbor and his friend shall perish.” ²² Thus says the LORD: “**Behold**, a people comes from the north country, and a great nation will be raised from the farthest parts of the earth. ²³ They will lay hold on bow and spear; they *are* cruel and have no mercy; their voice roars like the sea; and they ride on horses, as men of war set in array against you, O daughter of Zion.” ²⁴ We have heard the report of it; our hands grow feeble. **Anguish has taken hold of us, pain as of a woman in labor.** ²⁵ Do not go out into the field, nor walk by the way. Because of the sword of the enemy, fear *is* on every side. ²⁶ O daughter of my people, **dress in sackcloth** and roll about in ashes! Make mourning *as for* an only son, most bitter lamentation; for **the plunderer will suddenly come** upon us.

Jer 7:20-32 Therefore thus says the Lord GOD: “**Behold, My anger and My fury** will be poured out on this place—on man and on beast, on the trees of the field and on the fruit of the ground. And it will burn and not be quenched.” ²¹ Thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel: “Add your burnt offerings to your sacrifices and eat meat. ²² For I did not speak to your fathers, or command them in the day that I brought them out of the land of Egypt, concerning burnt offerings or sacrifices. ²³ But this is what I commanded them, saying, ‘Obey My voice, and I will be your God, and you shall be My people. And walk in all the ways that I have commanded you, that it may be well with you.’ ²⁴ Yet they did not obey or incline their ear, but followed the counsels *and* the dictates of their evil hearts, and went backward and not forward. ²⁵ Since the day that your fathers came out of the land of Egypt until this day, I have even sent to you all My servants the prophets, daily rising up early and sending *them*. ²⁶ Yet they did not obey Me or incline their ear, but stiffened their neck. They did worse than their fathers. ²⁷ “Therefore you shall

speaking all these words to them, but they will not obey you. You shall also call to them, but they will not answer you. ²⁸ “So you shall say to them, ‘This is a nation that does not obey the voice of the LORD their God nor receive correction. Truth has perished and has been cut off from their mouth. ²⁹ Cut off your hair and cast it away, and take up a lamentation on the desolate heights; for the LORD has rejected and forsaken **the generation of His wrath.**’ ³⁰ For the children of Judah have done evil in My sight,” says the LORD. “They have set their abominations in the house which is called by My name, to pollute it. ³¹ And they have built the high places of Tophet, which is in the Valley of the Son of Hinnom, to burn their sons and their daughters in the fire, which I did not command, nor did it come into My heart. ³² “Therefore **behold, the days are coming**,” says the LORD, “when it will no more be called Tophet, or the Valley of the Son of Hinnom, but the Valley of Slaughter; for they will bury in Tophet until there is no room. ³³ The corpses of this people will be food for the birds of the heaven and for the beasts of the earth. And no one will frighten *them* away. ³⁴ Then I will cause to cease from the cities of Judah and from the streets of Jerusalem the voice of mirth and the voice of gladness, the voice of the bridegroom and the voice of the bride. **For the land shall be desolate.**

Jer 8:8-17 “How can you say, ‘We *are* wise, and the law of the LORD is with us’? Look, the false pen of the scribe certainly works falsehood. ⁹ The wise men are ashamed, they are dismayed and **taken.** **Behold**, they have rejected the word of the LORD; so what wisdom do they have? ¹⁰ Therefore I will give their wives to others, *and* their fields to those who will inherit *them*; because from the least even to the greatest everyone is given to covetousness; from the prophet even to the priest Everyone deals falsely. ¹¹ For they have healed the hurt of the daughter of My people slightly, **Saying, ‘Peace, peace!’ When *there is no peace.*** ¹² Were they ashamed when they had committed abomination? No! They were not at all ashamed, nor did they know how to blush. Therefore they shall fall among those who fall; **in the time of their punishment** they shall be cast down,” says the LORD. ¹³ “I will surely consume them,” says the LORD. “No grapes *shall be* on the vine, nor figs on the fig tree, and the leaf shall fade; and *the things* I have given them shall pass away from them.”” ¹⁴ “Why do we sit still? Assemble yourselves, and let us

enter the fortified cities, and let us be silent there. For the LORD our God has put us to silence **and given us water of gall to drink**, because we have sinned against the LORD. ¹⁵ **"We looked for peace, but no good came; and for a time of health, and there was trouble!"** ¹⁶ The snorting of His horses was heard from Dan. **The whole land trembled at the sound of the neighing of His strong ones;** for they have come and devoured the land and all that is in it, the city and those who dwell in it." ¹⁷ **"For behold,** I will send serpents among you, Vipers which cannot be charmed, and they shall bite you," says the LORD.

Jer 9:7-25 ⁷ Therefore thus says the LORD of hosts: **"Behold, I will refine them and try them;** for how shall I deal with the daughter of My people? ⁸ Their tongue is an arrow shot out; it speaks deceit; one speaks peaceably to his neighbor with his mouth, but in his heart he lies in wait. ⁹ Shall I not punish them for these *things*?" says the LORD. "Shall I not avenge Myself on such a nation as this?" ¹⁰ I will take up a weeping and wailing for the mountains, and for the dwelling places of the wilderness a lamentation, because they are burned up, so that no one can pass through; nor can *men* hear the voice of the cattle. Both the birds of the heavens and the beasts have fled; they are gone. ¹¹ **"I will make Jerusalem a heap of ruins, a den of jackals. I will make the cities of Judah desolate, without an inhabitant."** ¹² Who is the wise man who may understand this? And *who is he* to whom the mouth of the LORD has spoken, that he may declare it? **Why does the land perish and burn up like a wilderness,** so that no one can pass through? ¹³ And the LORD said, *"Because they have forsaken My law which I set before them, and have not obeyed My voice, nor walked according to it, ¹⁴ but they have walked according to the dictates of their own hearts and after the Baals, which their fathers taught them,"* ¹⁵ therefore thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel: **"Behold, I will feed them, this people, with wormwood, and give them water of gall to drink. ¹⁶ I will scatter them** also among the Gentiles, whom neither they nor their fathers have known. And **I will send a sword after them** until I have consumed them." ¹⁷ Thus says the LORD of hosts: "Consider and call for the mourning women, that they may come; and send for skillful *wailing* women, that they may come. ¹⁸ Let

them make haste and take up a wailing for us, that our eyes may run with tears, and our eyelids gush with water. ¹⁹ For a voice of wailing is heard from Zion: ‘**How we are plundered!** We are greatly ashamed, because we have forsaken the land, because we have been cast out of our dwellings.’” ²⁰ Yet hear the word of the LORD, O women, and let your ear receive the word of His mouth; Teach your daughters wailing, and everyone her neighbor a lamentation. ²¹ **For death has come through our windows, has entered our palaces, to kill off the children— no longer to be outside!** And the young men— *no longer on the streets!* ²² Speak, “Thus says the LORD:

‘Even the carcasses of men shall fall as refuse on the open field, **like cuttings after the harvester**, and no one shall gather *them*.’” ²³ Thus says the LORD: “Let not the wise *man* glory in his wisdom, let not the mighty *man* glory in his might, nor let the rich *man* glory in his riches; ²⁴ **But let him who glories glory in this, that he understands and knows Me, that I am the LORD, exercising lovingkindness, judgment, and righteousness in the earth. For in these I delight,” says the LORD.** ²⁵ **“Behold, the days are coming,”** says the LORD, **“that I will punish all who are circumcised with the uncircumcised—** ²⁶ *Egypt, Judah, Edom, the people of Ammon, Moab, and all who are in the farthest corners, who dwell in the wilderness.* For all *these nations are* uncircumcised, and all the house of Israel *are* uncircumcised in the heart.”

Jer 10:17-25 Gather up your wares from the land, O inhabitant of the fortress! ¹⁸ For thus says the LORD: **“Behold,** I will throw out at this time the inhabitants of the land, and will distress them, that they may find *it so*.” ¹⁹ Woe is me for my hurt! My wound is severe. But I say, “Truly this *is* an infirmity, and I must bear it.” ²⁰ My tent is plundered, and all my cords are broken; My children have gone from me, and they *are* no more. *There is* no one to pitch my tent anymore, or set up my curtains. ²¹ For the shepherds have become dull-hearted, and have not sought the LORD; therefore they shall not prosper, and all their flocks shall be scattered. ²² **Behold,** the noise of the report has come, and **a great commotion out of the north country,** to make the cities of Judah desolate, a den of jackals. ²³ O LORD, I know the way of man *is* not in himself; *it is* not in man who

walks to direct his own steps. ²⁴ O LORD, correct me, but with justice; not in **Your anger**, lest You bring me to nothing. ²⁵ Pour out **Your fury** on the Gentiles, who do not know You, and on the families who do not call on Your name; For they have eaten up Jacob, devoured him and consumed him, and made his dwelling place desolate.

Jer 11:11-23 ¹¹Therefore thus says the LORD: “**Behold, I will surely bring calamity on them** which they will not be able to escape; and though they cry out to Me, I will not listen to them. ¹²Then the cities of Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem will go and cry out to the gods to whom they offer incense, but they will not save them at all in the **time of their trouble**. ¹³For *according to* the number of your cities were your gods, O Judah; and *according to* the number of the streets of Jerusalem you have set up altars to *that* shameful thing, altars to burn incense to Baal. ¹⁴“So do not pray for this people, or lift up a cry or prayer for them; for I will not hear *them* in the time that they cry out to Me because of their **trouble**. ¹⁵“What has **My beloved** to do in My house, having done lewd deeds with many? And the holy flesh has passed from you. When you do evil, then you rejoice. ¹⁶**The LORD called your name, Green Olive Tree, Lovely and of Good Fruit.** With the noise of a great tumult He has **kindled fire on it, and its branches are broken**. ¹⁷“For the LORD of hosts, who planted you, has **pronounced doom** against you for the evil of the house of Israel and of the house of Judah, which they have done against themselves to provoke Me to anger in offering incense to Baal.” ¹⁸Now the LORD gave me knowledge of *it*, and I know *it*; for You showed me their doings. ¹⁹But I *was* like a docile lamb brought to the slaughter; and I did not know that they had devised schemes against me, *saying*, “Let us destroy the tree with its fruit, and let us cut him off from the land of the living, that his name may be remembered no more.” ²⁰But, O LORD of hosts, You who judge righteously, testing the mind and the heart, Let me **SEE Your vengeance** on them, for to You I have revealed my cause. ²¹“Therefore thus says the LORD concerning the men of Anathoth who seek your life, saying, ‘Do not prophesy in the name of the LORD, lest you die by our hand’ — ²²therefore thus says the LORD of hosts: “**Behold, I will punish** them. The young men shall die by the sword, their sons and their daughters shall die by famine; ²³and there shall be **no remnant** of them, for I will bring catastrophe on the men of Anathoth, *even the year of their punishment*.”

Jer 13:12-21 “Therefore you shall speak to them this word: ‘Thus says the LORD God of Israel: “Every bottle shall be filled with wine.”’ And they will say to you, ‘Do we not certainly know that every bottle will be filled with wine?’”¹³ “Then you shall say to them, ‘Thus says the LORD: “**Behold, I will fill all the inhabitants of this land**—even the kings who sit on David’s throne, the priests, the prophets, and all the inhabitants of Jerusalem—**with drunkenness!**”’¹⁴ *And I will dash them one against another, even the fathers and the sons together,*” says the LORD. “I will not pity nor spare nor have mercy, but will destroy them.”’”¹⁵ Hear and give ear: Do not be proud, For the LORD has spoken.¹⁶ **Give glory to the LORD your God before He causes darkness, and before your feet stumble on the dark mountains, and while you are looking for light, He turns it into the shadow of death and makes it dense darkness.**¹⁷ But if you will not hear it, My soul will weep in secret for your pride; My eyes will weep bitterly and run down with tears, Because the LORD’s flock has been taken captive.¹⁸ Say to the king and to the queen mother, “Humble yourselves; sit down, for your rule shall collapse, the crown of your glory.”¹⁹ The cities of the South shall be shut up, and no one shall open *them*; Judah shall be carried away captive, all of it; It shall be wholly carried away captive.²⁰ **Lift up your eyes and see those who come from the north.** Where is the flock *that* was given to you, Your beautiful sheep?²¹ What will you say when He punishes you? For you have taught them to be chieftains, to be head over you. **Will not pangs seize you, like a woman in labor?**

Jer 25:29 ²⁹For **behold**, I begin to bring calamity on the city which is called by My name, and should you be utterly unpunished? You shall not be unpunished, for I will call for a sword on all the inhabitants of the earth," says the LORD of hosts.'

Micah 2:3-4 ³Therefore thus says the LORD:

“**Behold**, against this family **I am devising disaster**, from which you cannot remove your necks; nor shall you walk haughtily, for this is an evil time. ⁴In that day one shall take up a proverb against you, and lament with a bitter lamentation,

saying: 'We are utterly destroyed! He has changed the heritage of my people; how He has removed *it* from me! To a turncoat He has divided our fields.' ”
