Ironwood Economic Develoopment Corporation

The Ironwood Economic Development Corporation is made up of business entrepreneurs and professionals who locate in the City of Ironwood. The IEDC is tasked with helping employers through creating a business supportive atmosphere and philosophies.

Commercial Properties Listing

The City utilizes a website through the MEDC to list commercial properties located within the City, that are either for sale, or for rent. The listings are populated using the MLS or entered manually.

Gogebic County Brownfield Authority

The GCBRA, through a variety of mechanisms and authorizations, can provide significant incentives to facilitate the redevelopment of Brownfield sites throughout Gogebic County. Primary incentives include tax increment financing (TIF) planning and the management of brownfield grants and loans.
