

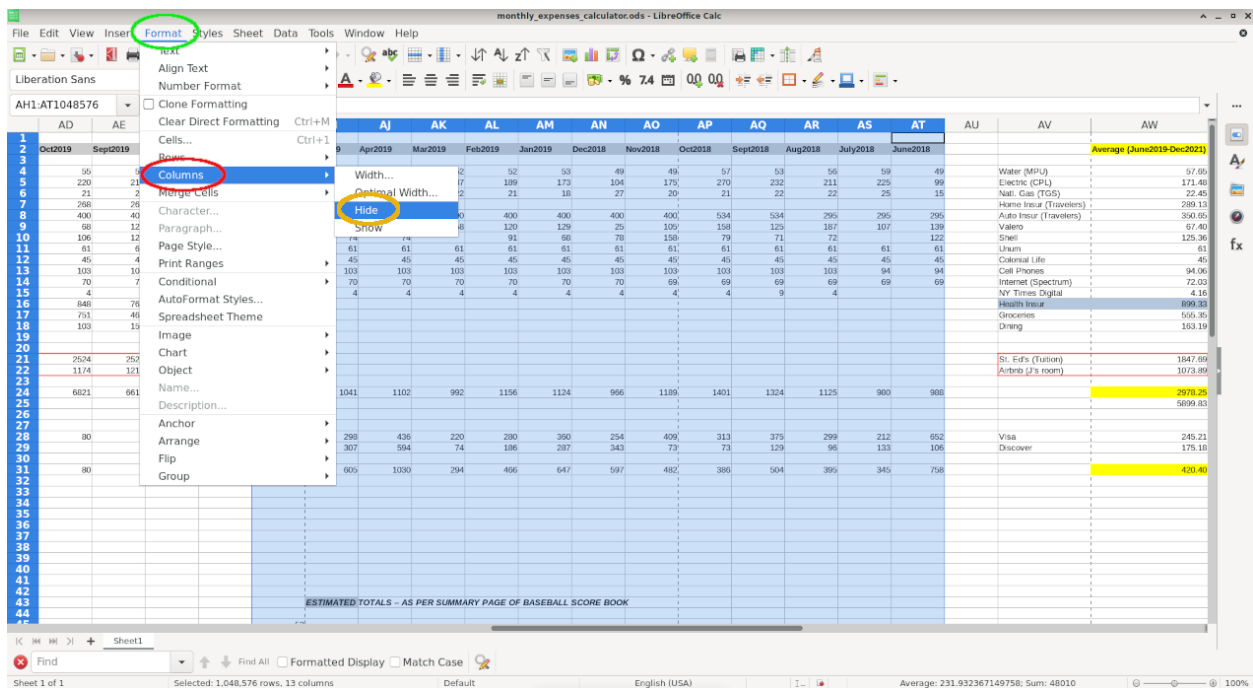
LibreOffice Calc: Hide or Unhide Columns

(Ver. 7.2 ; Last updated: 15 Jan. 2022)

Hide Columns -- Method 1

Click to select the columns you wish to hide.

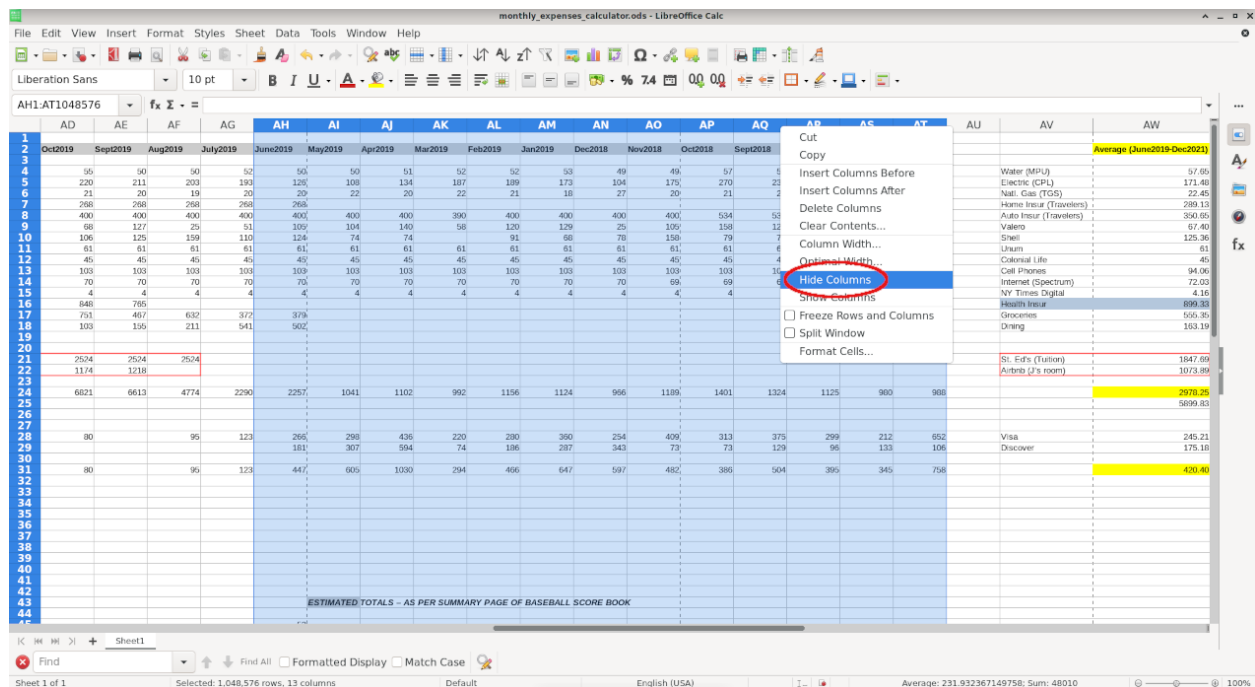
Format > Columns > Hide (or, Show)



Hide Columns -- Method 2

Click to select the columns you wish to hide.

Right-click, then choose Hide Columns.



Unhiding Columns -- Method 1

Click to select the columns on each side of the hidden column range you want to restore.

Do the reverse of the hiding process, i.e., Format > Columns > Show

Unhiding Columns -- Method 2

Click to select the columns on each side of the hidden column range you want to restore.

Do the reverse of the hiding process, i.e., right-click then choose Show Columns.

If Unhiding Columns Doesn't Work ...

In the Name box [upper left quadrant of spreadsheet], type the range of columns you want to unhide, e.g. AH:AT

Press Enter.

Then, Format > Columns > Show

The hidden columns should reappear.
