Office Category

- LibreOffice (via Pinoc's LibreOffice Manager script)
- SpeedCrunch (a Qt-based calculator)
- Eqonomize (a Qt-based personal finance / checkbook program)¹

Internet Category

- Trojita (a Qt-based e-mail client)²
- qBittorrent (a Qt-based Torrent client)

Multimedia

- QMPlay2 (installed by default [?])³
- Yarock (Qt-based music player)⁴
- "task-multimedia" package (make sure to install this)

Utilities

- task-printing package
- task-obsolete package
- fastrepo package
- htop package
- psensor package (for monitoring PC temp, memory usage)
- zip package⁵

Not in the PCLOS repositories, but is available as an AppImage (see http://eqonomize.github.io/downloads.html). Just make the AppImage executable, and you can run it without needing to install it. I have been experimenting with it for a few weeks and it works fine (although it is not as full-featured as programs like GnuCash, HomeBank, Skrooge, KMyMoney, etc.).
