
Flushing Map

Flushing your home plumbing system

- Take a water meter reading before and after running your cold water and give readings and your address to the water department for a credit on your utility bill.
- ♦ Flush ALL cold water taps until clear.
- Avoid using hot water until cold water runs clear.
- Flush ALL appliances such as Ice Makers, Dishwashers, Washing Machines, Water Filters and Softeners etc..
- After flushing your water, filters may need to be replaced, if located at point of entry.


