## **City of Ironwood Water System/Hydrant Flushing**

The City of Ironwood will begin water system flushing late Sunday evening, October 19th, 2025, through Friday morning, October 24th, 2025. Flushing will generally occur overnight during this period. The schedule of areas to be flushed is as follows:

### **AREA 1**

Sunday (pm) 10/19 – Monday (am) 10/20

All areas north of US-2 from the Montreal River to Roosevelt Street

### **AREA 2**

Monday (pm) 10/20 – Tuesday (am) 10/21

All areas south of US-2 to Frederick Street from Norrie Street to North Lake Street, and all areas north of East Ayer Street from Lake Street to Country Club Road

### **AREA 3**

Tuesday (pm) 10/21 – Wednesday (am) 10/22

All areas south of the railroad grade to McLeod Avenue and Vaughn Street from the Montreal River to Lake Street, and the Jessieville area including the Newport Heights Location

### **AREA 4**

Wednesday (pm) 10/22 – Thursday (am) 10/23

All areas south of the caves area including the Norrie and Ashland Locations and neighborhoods of South Range Road, VanBuskirk Road, and Norrie Park Road

### **Miscellaneous Areas**

Thursday (pm) 10/23 – Friday (am) 10/24

Miscellaneous areas that need to be cleaned again and/or monitored.

When flushing occurs in your neighborhood, the accumulated sediment in the watermains will be stirred up and much of the sediment will be flushed out of the system. However, due to limitations on the system, some sediment will remain, causing discolored water. If your water appears discolored, it is recommended that you give it time to clear up, then run your cold-water faucet for a few minutes to make sure the discolored water is cleared. If you need to run cold water for longer, please contact the number below.

If your water pressure seems lower than normal, try removing and rinsing the screens from your filters or sink faucets, as sediment may collect there during flushing.

We recommend water customers avoid washing laundry during the period hydrants are flushed in their area. Water service should not be interrupted, and no boil advisories are required because of this process.
