President's Report: September

1. <u>The SRO (School Reform Officer) threatens to close schools based on test scores that Districts</u> were promised would not be used until three years of valid data could be gathered.

Various organizations representing MI school administrators (Dr. Rice included), school boards, MEA and AFT are fighting the privatization of public education. Since these organizations began fighting back, the SRO has backed away from her aggressive stance, saying a smaller number of schools will face closure. Regardless of the number, it is wrong to make this type of decision based on flawed information and broken promises. Steve Cook, MEA President said, "Closing schools and threatening dedicated school employees does nothing to help children or improve struggling schools-most of which operate in impoverished areas in need of investment and support."

The Governor moved the SRO from the Michigan Department of Education (MDE), which is under the oversight of the Democrat-controlled State Board of Education, to the Department of Technology, Management and Budget under his control.
