For Summer Employment

The City of Ironwood Public Works Department is accepting applications for summer employment until 4:00 p.m. on Friday, March 23, 2018. Applications can be picked up at the City Clerks Office or from the City website at www.cityofironwood.org/government/departments or brought to the City Clerk's Office, 213 S. Marquette Street, Ironwood, MI 49938.

The employee will perform such duties as grass care, tree trimming and routine maintenance of Cemetery, grounds and facilities. Other duties include, but are not limited to, raking, tree trimming, cutting and weed-eating grass throughout the city, top soiling city grounds where needed, assist with the trimming of trees and removal of brush, debris and general maintenance activities.

Qualifications: Must be at least 18 years old, have a valid driver's license, be a self-starter, work with minimal supervision, and be able to operate a lawn mower, weed eater, small power tools and hand equipment.

This is a temporary, seasonal position of 40 hours/week. Employee will be paid \$10.25 per hour with no benefits. Hours will be set by the Public Works Supervisor.
