REQUEST FOR PROPOALS

SNOW DUMPING AT CITY COMPOST SITE

The City of Ironwood is soliciting bids for dumping snow at the City Compost Site for the 2023/24 winter season. The selected business will be able to haul and dump snow from local residential properties into the location within the Compost Site as shown in the attached map. Please note the following:

- 1. The selected Contractor will be required to keep the Compost Site access gate shut and locked at all times when the site is not being used.
- 2. The Contractor will be required to plow the access road from Ayer St into the snow dump area. The City does not plow this road during the winter.
- 3. The Contractor will be required to remove garbage from the snow pile as it melts in the Spring. This will need to be done on a weekly basis so that the garbage is not blowing into the surrounding woods and Compost Site area.
- 4. In the spring, the Contractor will need to restore the snow dump area and access road to similar condition as it was prior to the winter. This includes removal of garbage as discussed above, repairing any ruts in the access road, and fixing any drainage issues that didn't exist prior to the winter. The Contractor will not be required to remove the sands that are within the melted snow, as long as they are not making their way into surrounding drainage systems. If sand fills up drainage ditches, then the Contractor will be required to clean out the drainage ditches.
- 5. Minimum Bid Amount: there is no minimum bid amount.

Sealed offers will be received by the Ironwood City Clerk in the Memorial Building, Ironwood, Michigan 49938, until 10:00 A.M. local time Wednesday, November 22, 2023, at which time the bids shall be read aloud. The City reserves the right to accept or reject any and all bids.
