2. Documentation Requirements

- Applicants must provide a project update and financial documentation within 30 days after project completion.

Example 3: Mountain Biking Trail Expansion

- **Request:** \$25,000 (matched by a state recreation grant)
- **Funding Use:** Development of new biking trails, construction of a skills park, installation of trail maps.
- **Community Benefit:** Attracts outdoor enthusiasts, contributing to local businesses and tourism growth.
