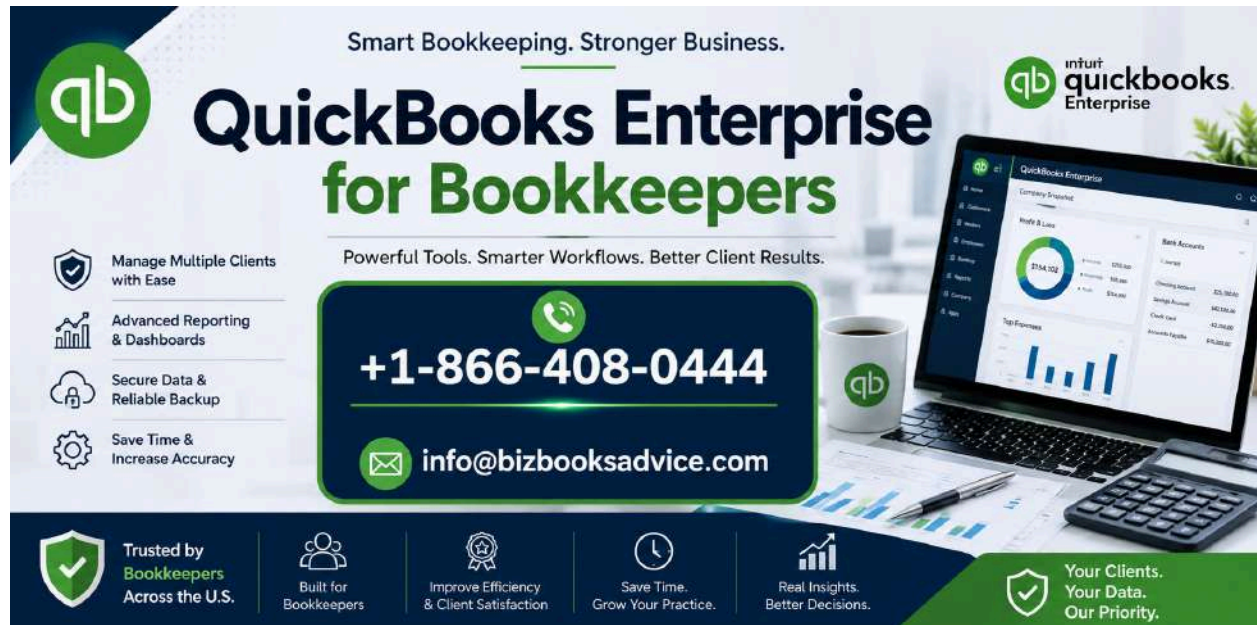

Bank transactions typically fail to appear in QuickBooks Online because of a narrow date filter, a delayed bank feed, a silently disconnected account, or a posting delay on the bank's own side. This is different from a [QuickBooks banking errors](#) message — in this case, there's often no visible error at all, which is what makes it confusing. Checking the filter settings and manually refreshing the feed resolves most cases.
