

7. HOW IS AMERICANS ALL 2.0 FUNDED?

After the pilot registration phase reaches meaningful participation, the program will move into its implementation phase. At that point, participants will begin to interact financially through the platform.

Recurring support for schools and other nonprofit businesses is generated through participation in the program, including:

- \$4 per month, if billed annually, for individual members
- \$6.50 per month, if billed monthly, for individual members
- \$8 per month, if billed twice a year, for participating businesses
- \$10.50 per month if billed monthly, for participating businesses

Where does the money go?

Of the total revenue generated:

- 75% is distributed directly to participating schools.
- 15% is distributed to affiliated state or regional participating organizations. If none exist, those funds go directly to the school.
- 3% covers credit card processing fees.
- 7% supports program operations and administration.

Are there hidden fees or donations required?

No. Americans All 2.0 is designed around voluntary participation and the stated membership and business participation fees. There are no long-term commitments required for Americans All 2.0 membership.

Does the school receive the money directly?

Participating schools receive 75% of the total gross revenue generated. An additional 15% is distributed to affiliated state or regional participating organizations; if none exist, those funds go directly to the school.

Why does the program have a business participation fee?

The business participation fee is part of the funding model that allows businesses to participate in the platform while helping generate recurring financial support for schools and other nonprofit businesses.

What happens as participation grows?

As more individuals, families, businesses, schools, and other nonprofit businesses participate, the platform can generate greater ongoing financial support while creating more opportunities for everyone involved.
